Show Information

Membership

Exhibitors must hold a current NOHSA Exhibitor Membership and all horses must hold a current NOHSA Competition Registration. [Exhibitor Memberships](#) and [Competition Registrations](#) can be purchased online or at the show. Membership fees are \$30 for adults and \$20 for youth, annually. Competition Registrations are \$10 per horse, annually.

Entries

The entry fees for all classes are as outlined below. Exhibitors may pre-enter online via Horse Show Tracker or enter at the show office. All entries changed, or substituted after entries are submitted must be made in person at the show office. Entries made after the draw has been posted will show at the beginning of the working order. No exceptions. Scratches will only be accepted in person at the show office or back gate. Scratches cannot be made on Horse Show Tracker. Exhibitor age is as of January 1.

Stalls

All horses are required to have a paid stall or pay the applicable jumpout fee per day. [Stall reservations](#) will become available for purchase online on July 22. Stalls purchased before the stall deadline 5:00 p.m. (CST) on September 28 are available at the horse show rate of \$165. For stalls purchased after the stall deadline, there is an additional \$15 fee per stall. Any additions/changes to reservations made after this date are not guaranteed to be placed with the original reservation. Stalls will not be available for purchase after 5:00 p.m. on October 20. Full stall includes Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights. Horses requiring early arrival or late stay require an additional fee.

Health Papers

Per facility regulations, all horses, including in-state horses, are required to present a negative EIA test (Coggins) within the past 12 months, an original Health Certificate within 14 days of the show, and proof of EHV1 and EHV4 (Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus/Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months.

Stalling Group

For individuals who want to purchase stalls separately but be stalled together, a group name must be designated for each stalling location when completing your stall reservation. Stalls must be paid before assignment and will be subject to the appropriate fees based on the date payment is received.

Arrivals & Departures

Move-in begins on Thursday, October 23 at 8:00 a.m. All horses are required to check in with the facility upon arrival.

Feed & Bedding

[Feed and Bedding](#) will be available for purchase directly from the facility within seven days of the show.

Camping

RV camping is available on the grounds at \$80 per night. Electric, water, and sewer hookups are included. Guests must check in upon their arrival at the General Store. [RV Reservations](#) must be received by September 28.

Hotel

Rooms are available at The Riding Academy Hotel/Event Center on the grounds for a reduced rate. [Hotel Reservations](#) must be received by September 28 to receive the show rate.

Rules and Regulations

Classes will be judged by NSBA rules as written in the [NSBA Official Handbook](#). This includes all class and equipment rules unless otherwise defined in the NOHSA official handbook.

Divisions

Small Fry 11 & Under classes are Walk/Jog or Walk/Trot. Exhibitors that are showing in a Walk/Jog or Walk/Trot class are not allowed to enter a class that requires a lope or a canter. Horses may cross-enter these classes with separate exhibitors.

Awards

All classes will have ribbons through sixth place. Additionally, NOHSA Bucks will be awarded through sixth place in all classes, which can be redeemed for prizes or gift cards in the NOHSA Award Shop at the show.

High-Point Awards

A High-Point Award will be awarded to the winningest exhibitor in the following categories: Small Fry 11 & Under, Youth 13 & Under, Youth 14-18, Amateur 19-49, Amateur 50 & Over, Ranch, Over Fences, Walk Trot.

Added Money

All \$250 Added classes will be held with six or more entries. Prize money will be awarded to the exhibitor that earned the placing. The class will be paid out per the payback schedule below.
