## Show Information

### Qualifying

Exhibitors can qualify by showing at **one eligible open horse show before September 1, 2024** and submitting an Exhibitor Results Report within 30 days. Eligible events include any horse show not sanctioned by a national association (not including 4-H or FFA). Qualifying is based on each horse and exhibitor combination. A current qualifying list is available at [www.nohsa.net](http://www.nohsa.net).

### Membership

All horses and exhibitors must be registered with NOHSA. Memberships and Competition Registrations can be purchased online at [www.nohsa.net](http://www.nohsa.net).

### Entries

The entry fee for all classes is \$15. Enter online at [www.nohsa.net](http://www.nohsa.net) August 1 – September 10. All entries may be changed or scratched up until this deadline. All entries made, changed, or substituted after September 10 must be made at the show, will incur a \$10 post-entry fee, and are non-refundable. Entries will not be accepted after draws have been posted. Exhibitor age is as of January 1.

### Stalls

All horses are required to have a paid stall. Stalls purchased before 11:59 p.m. on August 28 are available at the horse show rate of \$150. For stalls purchased after August 28, there is an additional \$15 fee per stall. Any additions/changes to reservations made after this date are not guaranteed to be placed with the original reservation.

### Health Papers

Per facility regulations, **all horses**, including in-state horses, are required to present a negative EIA test (Coggins) within the past 12 months, an original Health Certificate within 14 days of the show, and proof of EHV1 and EHV4 (Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus/Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months.

### Stalling Group

One group name must be designated for each stalling group. Priority stalling will be given to sponsors, by level and date of payment. Sponsorship payment must be made by August 28 for stalling perks. Stalls must be paid before assignment and will be subject to the appropriate fees based on the date payment is received.

### Arrivals & Departures

Move-in begins on Thursday, September 19 at 8:00 a.m. All horses are required to check in upon arrival.

### Feed & Bedding

Feed and bedding will be available for purchase directly from the facility within seven days of the show—more information to come.

### Camping

RV camping is available on the grounds at \$75 per night. Electric, water, and sewer hookups are included. Guests must check in upon their arrival at the General Store. Reservations must be received by August 19.

### Rules and Regulations

Classes will be judged by NSBA rules as written in the association's official handbook. This includes all class and equipment rules unless otherwise defined in the NOHSA official handbook.

### Divisions

Small Fry 11 & Under are Walk/Jog or Walk/Trot. Exhibitors that are showing in a Walk/Jog or Walk/Trot class are not allowed to enter a class that requires a lope or a canter. Horses may cross-enter these classes with separate exhibitors. Visit [www.nohsa.net](http://www.nohsa.net) for EWD requirements.
